

Speakers of the Board of Managing Directors / Chief Executive Officers

The post of Speaker of the Board of Managing Directors has not always been occupied by just one person, but alternated between various board members, explaining the overlaps in the list. After the Second World War, nine regional branch groups were established in 1947/48. In 1952, these groups were consolidated into three successor banks reflecting three main administrative centres in Hamburg, Düsseldorf and Frankfurt. The process of centralisation in Frankfurt am Main began in 1970.
