All applicants must expect to or have already achieved a minimum 2.1 UK degree or above (or equivalent). You must have a minimum of 320 UCAS points required (or equivalent). We accept applications from all degree disciplines. Your strengths include analytical thinking and dealing confidently with people. You have already acquired practical experience within financial institutions during a number of internships. You are an excellent communicator in English and ideally in another language (depending on business area). You are committed to your work and keep a cool head, even in stressful situations. What's more, you're a team player.

## Applications and the selection procedure

Corporate Client areas in London traditionally source Graduates through former interns so you first need to apply for one of the internships advertised on our external job board. Your application will initially be screened by the HR team. If successful, the business will shortlist the remaining applications to decide who they would like to invite for a series of interviews. Upon successful completion of your internship, the business may offer you a place on the Graduate programme dependent upon your performance and individual fit. Former interns do not need to attend an Assessment Centre in order to join the programme.
