All applicants must expect to or have already achieved a minimum 2.1 UK degree or above (or equivalent). You must have a minimum of 320 UCAS points required (or equivalent). We accept applications from all degree disciplines, however our preferred disciplines are: Economics, Mathematics, Computer Science or Engineering. Your strengths include analytical thinking and dealing confidently with people. You have already acquired practical experience within financial institutions during a number of internships. You are an excellent communicator in English and ideally in another language (depending on business area). You are committed to your work and keep a cool head, even in stressful situations.
